Social media graphics:

<u>Canva</u> (free + paid version – you can get a free "pro account" as a charity)

Kapwing (free + paid version)

Adobe Spark (free + paid version)

Unfold (free, app only) – this helps design Instagram Stories

Scheduling your social media in advance:

You can now do more scheduling than before directly on social media platforms.

Here's how you can schedule tweets on Twitter via the Web App. When drafting a tweet, just click on the calendar icon and schedule. <u>Tweetdeck</u> is also a really good way to schedule tweets. You can also add columns for accounts or hashtags that you want to keep an eye on like #RefugeeWeek2021

You can use the <u>Facebook Creator Studio</u> to manage Instagram and Facebook posts.

Third party-social media scheduling:

There are also various third-party social media tools you can use. Most of these are free, with limitations on no. of posts or no. of social media channels you can use.
